June 12th Meeting?

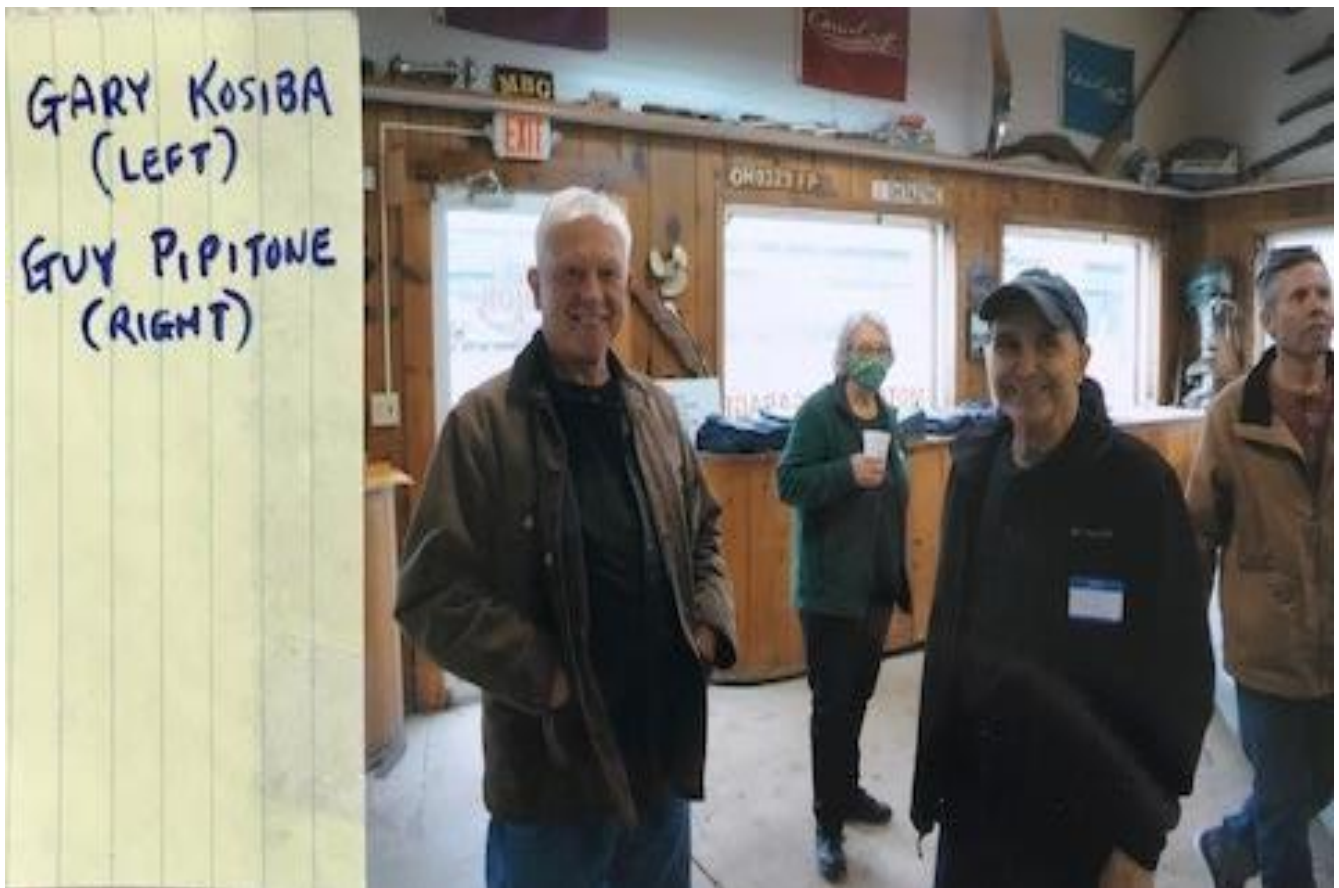

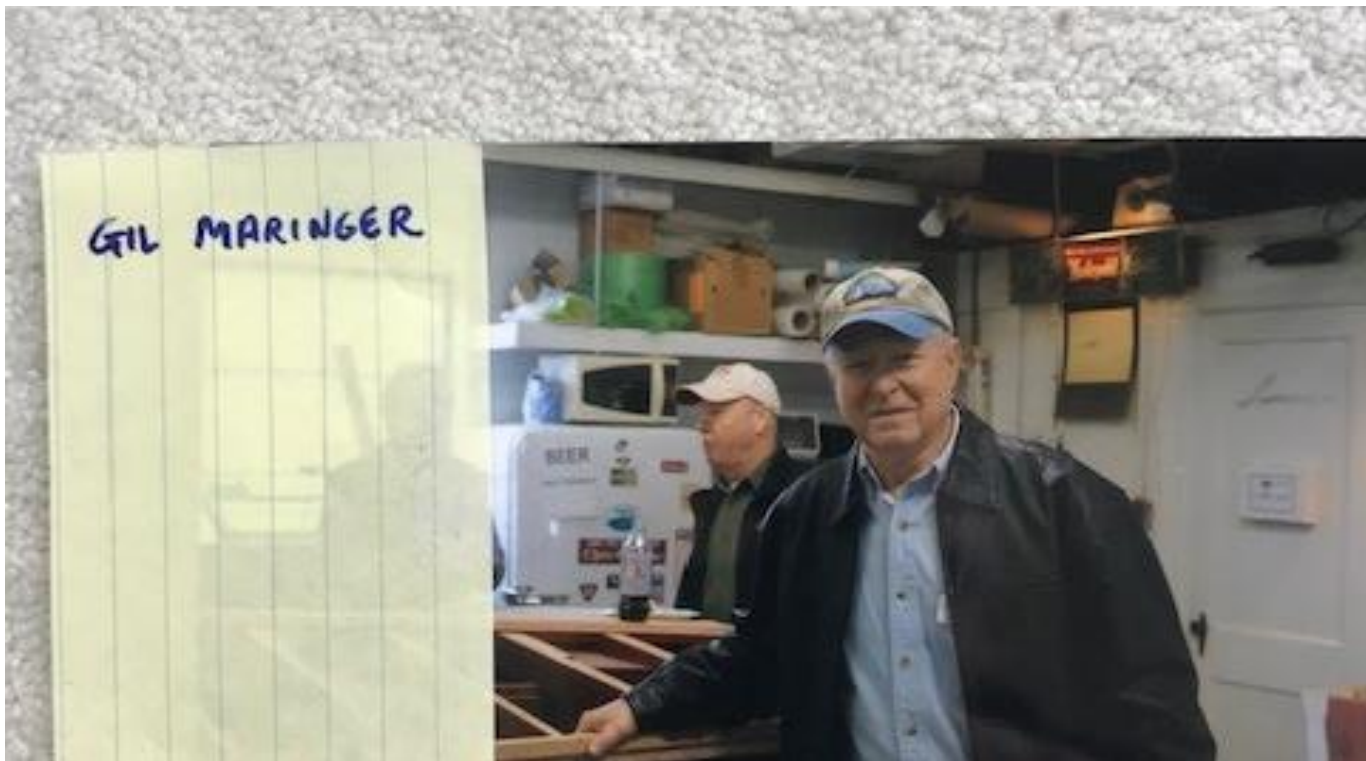
